

- Encouraging young mentors into specialist or general further education and into work.







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
Our Workshop Facilitators are at the heart of everything we do at The Offshoot Foundation.

As a Faciltiator, you will work alongside colleagues to deliver workshops for young people up to the age of 25. You will support and coach participants in communication, teamwork, and creative expression.

Depending on the project, workshops may involve producing movie trailers, music videos, stop motion animations, short films and more.

As a Workshop Facilitator, you will deliver creative, engaging workshops that inspire and help young people (up to the age of 25) develop their communication, teamwork, and creative skills through film, media, and digital storytelling.



Responsibilitites.

- Plan and deliver workshops in line with briefs from the Lead Facilitator or CEO, collaborating with other facilitators, as required.
- Support and coach young people to build confidence, communication, and teamwork.
- Encourage creativity through projects such as short films, music videos, stop-motion animation, and movie trailers.
- Create a safe, inclusive and inspiring environment for participants.
- Adapt workshop delivery to meet the needs of all abilities of different groups.
- Represent The Offshoot Foundation professionally when working with young people, schools, and community partners.
- Complete relevant safeguarding, health & safety, and administrative requirements (including registers, feedback, and reports when needed)

- Strong alignment with The Offshoot Foundation's mission and values.
- Knowledge of film production, editing and use of filmmaking equipment.
- Editing skills (e.g. iMovie, Final Cut, Capcut, or equivalent).
- Experience of working as part of a team.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Proactive, adaptable, and solutions-focused approach.
- Ability to manage confidential information with professionalism.
- Enhanced DBS check (or willingness to obtain via The Offshoot Foundation).
- Safeguarding training (or willingness to complete).

- Full driving license, or reliable access to workshop locations.
